VICTORIA USBC 2025 SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

Scholarships in the amount of up to \$1,000 may be awarded. Judging will be based on a point system including: scholastic ability, citizenship, need, extracurricular activities, and commitment to the sport of bowling.

TO QUALIFY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

Applicants must either be a graduating high school senior with a scholastic average of 80 or above, or currently enrolled in a postsecondary college, university, or program with a GPA of 2.50 or above. The applicant shall not be over the age of 25 at the close of the application window. The applicant must be a current member of the Victoria USBC (youth or adult league).

TO APPLY FOR THE 2025 SCHOLARSHIP, PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- Completed application form (see reverse side) with the following information:
 - A list of volunteer activities (including, but not limited to, community, school, church, or USBC events. Include the approximate number of hours spent on each activity and the name of the activities sponsor, if any. All volunteer activities during high school and/or college should be included.
 - A list of part-time or summer jobs held during high school and/or college, including the number of hours per week, length of job and the name of the supervisor.
 - A list of activities during high school and/or college, including clubs, sports (includes intramural), and/or scholastic competitions.
 - A statement of the number of years of participation in certified league play (lifetime) in Victoria and other associations, if applicable.
- A current transcript—official or unofficial.
